

YOUTH INDOOR ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIP 2026



Schedule:

July 11, 2026 - Day 1: Qualifications - 8am to 5pm

July 12, 2026 - Day 2: Eliminations and Finals - 8am to 5pm

Venue:

National Gymnasium, Mandela Avenue, Georgetown.

Competition Information:

A minimum of three (3) registered participants is required for an event to be contested.

Divisions:

1. Recurve
2. Compound
3. Barebow

Class:

1. Under 15 Men
2. Under 15 Women
3. Under 18 Men
4. Under 18 Women
5. Under 21 Men
6. Under 21 Women

Distance:

1. 18 Meters
2. Recurve & Barebow Shot on a 40cm Target Face (Full Face 1-10 Scoring Rings)
3. Compound: Shot on vertical Triple Face

Eligibility:

- Open to all affiliated youth archers.
- Participants must compete in their eligible age category (Class).
 - Under 15 Class when the competition takes place up to and in the year of the athlete's 14th birthday.
 - Under 18 Class when the competition takes place up to and in the year of the athlete's 17th birthday.
 - Under 21 Class when the competition takes place up to and in the year of the athlete's 20th birthday.
- Proof of age may be requested.

Competition Format

World Archery Rules apply

QUALIFICATION ROUNDS – 60 arrows divided into 20 ends of 3 arrows each.

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ELIMINATION ROUNDS:

1. Recurve – Set system (The first archer to 6 points wins the match play).
2. Compound – Cumulative Score System. (Archers will shoot 5 ends of 3 arrows each, the archer with the higher score out of 150 wins the match.
3. Barebow - Set system (The first archer to 6 points wins the match play).

TEAM ROUNDS

1. Men (Made up of three participants of the same category)
2. Women (Made up of three participants of the same category)
3. Mix (Made up of two participants One male, One Female of the same category)

Only persons registered under a club can compete in the Team events under that Club. The Club must present the names of their registered Team members 15 mins after the announcement of seeding.

National Rankings & National Team Consideration

Performances will be recorded and used for national archery rankings. Recorded Scores along with consistent scoring results shall factor in the selection of a national high level training squad, also for future national team selection. As such this event will count to the registered archer's performance record which will be kept in the national database. Further criteria will apply such as WADA regulations, RADO and NADO requirements, etc.

Fee: GYD \$6,000 (Non-Refundable)

Late Registration Deadline: Wednesday, 8 July 2026 at 5:00 pm.

Late Registration Fee: GYD \$10,000 (Non-Refundable)
